Joan Lombardi is the Director of The Children's Project and Chair of the Birth to Five Policy Alliance. She serves as an advisor to a number of foundations and innovative policy initiatives within the United States and around the world and is a Research Professor at the Public Policy Institute, Georgetown University. Joan served as the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Policy and External Affairs in the Administration for Children and Families, US Department of Health and Human Services, and as the first director of the Child Care Bureau.

In 2004, Joan launched Global Leaders for Young Children, in partnership with The World Forum Foundation and served as a senior fellow with The Global Fund for Children. Currently she is on the Educational Leadership Council of Save the Children and on the boards of Global Action for Children and Voices for America's Children.
