Ben Allen, Ph.D., is the Research and Evaluation Director for the National Head Start Association in Alexandria, Virginia. In this position, Allen has authored special reports; managed the *NHSA Dialog: A Research-to-Practice Journal for the Early Intervention Field* and *Dialog Briefs*; has testified on appropriate child assessments and outcomes before the National Research Council Committee on Developmental Outcomes and Assessments for Young Children; directed survey research projects on various Head Start-related topics; and educated the Head Start community, media, and congressional staff about Head Start research.
